Justification for course proposal:

The course change is to the catalog description, prerequisites, semester offered, and the K-factor to be changed from generating 4.5 units of work for the course to 0.25 WTUs per student, which is consistent with every other clinical course in our CSAD department. In recent years, there has been an increased enrollment in our department. Changing the pay structure will allow faculty to be paid accurately for the amount of work they are expected to do.

The current catalog description is outdated and does not reflect current enrollment criteria or accurate information regarding the semester offered. Placement site options have also changed, necessitating an update here to include medical settings.
