Sealed proposals will be received in the Procurement and Contract Services Office on **May 15th, 2018 at 2:00 p.m.**, in accordance with the bid documents, at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read. The bid must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Forms provided by the University, completely filled out and sealed in an envelope.

All contractors and all tiers of subcontractors bidding on this project shall register to bid public works projects with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), and maintain current this registration pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. In accordance with Public Contract Code Section 3300, the University has determined that the project requires a **B or C-15 license**.

All work awarded under the contract that results from this bid will be issued as Individual Task Orders.

- The successful bidder must complete all of the Job Task Orders within a period of 365 calendar days.
- The bid shall be awarded based on the total from the unit prices as listed on the Unit Price Sheet included in the Specifications. The Unit Pricing shall be used to price each Task Order during the term of the contract.
- No changes to the Unit Prices shall be allowed during the term of the contract.
- The awarded contractor shall be required to provide payment and performance bonds for 100% of the contract amount which is estimated at \$600,000.00 for the 365 day period. Costs for the bonds are to be included in the Base Bid and cannot be billed for outside of Task Orders.

SMALL BUSINESS PREFERENCE will be granted to bidders properly approved as "Small Business" in accordance with Title 2, California Administrative Code, Section 1896 et seq.

DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION (DVBE) is required for this project.
