


## What if my “Hamburger” is Missing?


Many of our documents refer to the “hamburger” in FDW. This is what we call the “hamburger”:




The “hamburger” is an image that consists of three horizontal lines in the top-right corner of the FDW screen. It may also be called the “page options menu”, “menu icon” or the “menu drawer”.

It is possible that a user will not have the hamburger on their FDW screen. If that happens to you, the following procedure may restore the hamburger to your screen:

1. Edit your FDW profile:
  - a. Click the drop-down arrow next to your name.
  - b. Click “My Account”



2. Select the Preferences tab.
3. Select “Accessibility Mode” = “Off”.



4. Refresh your browser screen. A restart or logout is not necessary.
