

ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)

Who We Are

The Associate Degree for Transfer is a pathway for transfer students who earned an AA-T or AS-T at a California Community College to complete a degree at Sacramento State with a total of 120 units.

Benefits

- Eligible to have the English 20 requirement waived (Graduation Requirement, NOT CSU GE AREA A3)
- Eligible for priority registration in their second semester (via CA Promise/Through in Two)
- Access to Transfer Peer Coaches
- For Impacted Majors: Courses allowed in progress the semester prior to enrollment. Some pre-requisite courses are allowed to be taken as part of the 60 units at Sac State
- For Business Majors: 7 year currency waived



Transfer Peer Coaches

- Current Sac State students who earned an ADT prior to transferring
- Outreach at local community colleges
- Classroom presentations to promote ADT
- Campus resource for current transfer students
- Social media ambassadors for Facebook and Instagram




Demographics of Students






