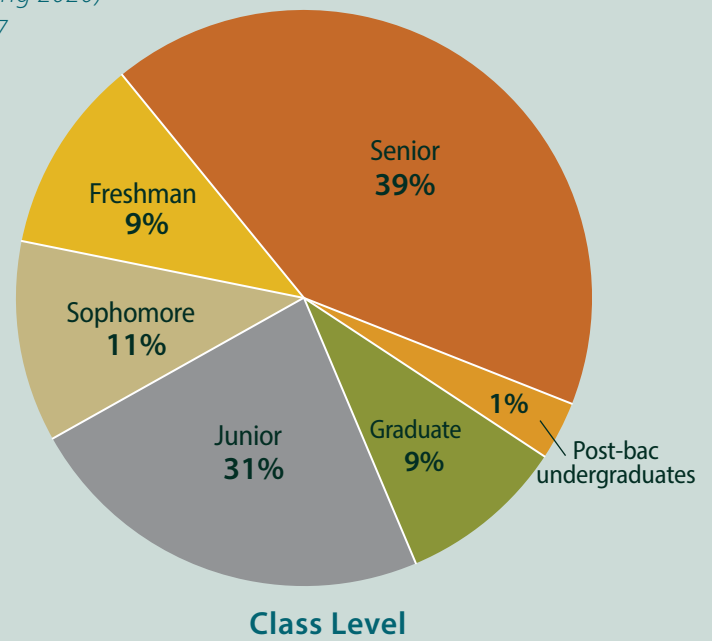
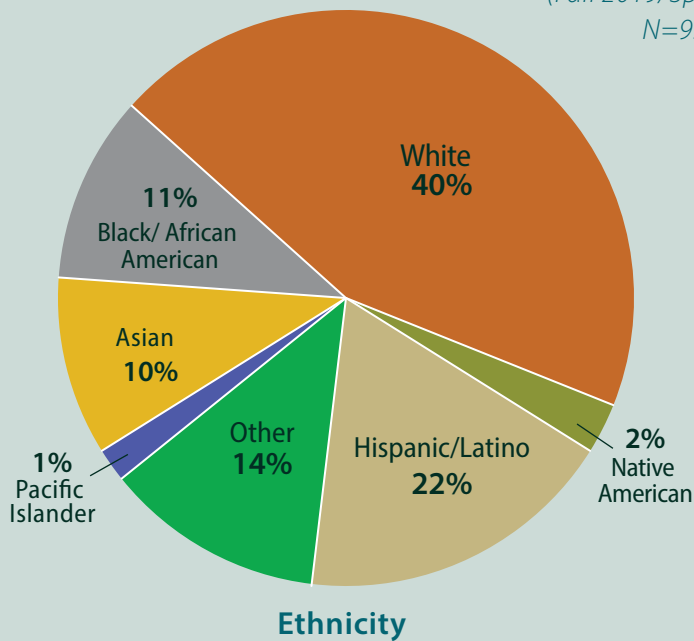
Who we are

N=957

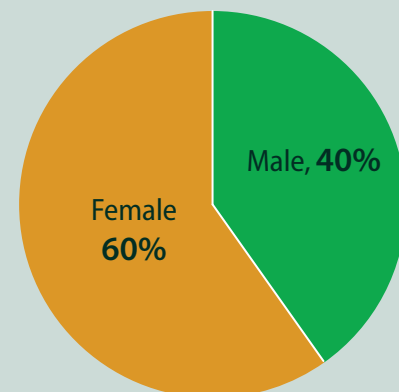

Services

TRIO Student Support Services Program

- Federally funded outreach and service program for students with disabilities from low-income backgrounds.
- **2018-2019 Results**
 - **88%** of TRIO students persisted in the fall term of the next academic year or graduated with a bachelor's degree during the reporting year.
 - **96%** of TRIO students who met the performance level required to stay in good academic standing.
 - **94%** of TRIO students from cohort year 2013-2014 graduated with a bachelor's degree within six reporting years.



Access Accommodations

- Services may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - assistance regarding the admission process
 - academic advising/course selection assistance referrals
 - career development and guidance referrals
 - counseling: academic, personal or vocational
 - financial aid advising/scholarship information referrals
 - housing assistance and information
 - registration assistance
 - tutoring information referrals



Testing Accommodations

- In partnership with the Testing Center, SSWD students are provided with auxiliary aids such as readers, scribes, and/or appropriate assistive technology.
